When Carl tells his survival story you'll be in awe. Then when he stands and sings "If I Were a Rich Man!" your kids and everybody'll

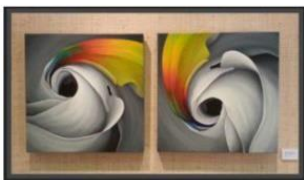
